CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION

- Instructions for use shall be provided with each lifejacket. As prescribed by SOLAS Regulation III/35 one or more additional copies shall be provided for inclusion in the vessel's Training Manual
- The lifejacket is approved only for use by children with a minimum weight of 15 Kg but less than 43 kg and a minimum height of 100 cm but less than 155 cm
- Each lifejacket shall also be clear marked with the information required by LSA Code as amended by Regulation I/1.2.2.9 and II/2.2.1.10
- As prescribed by SOLAS Regulation III/36 and where applicable, lifejackets shall be maintained as per manufacturer's instructions
- An approved lifejacket light meeting the requirements of the LSA Code as amended by Regulation II/2.2.3 is to be fitted when supplied to SOLAS vessels. The light is to be tested and meet the requirements of IMO Resolution MSC.81 (70), Part 1, 10.3 and 10.4 and is attachment have to be to the satisfaction of the attending Surveyors
- Each lifejacket shall be fitted with a whistle firmly secured by a lanyard as per LSA Code as amended by Regulation II/2.2.1.14
- Each lifejacket shall be provided with a releasable buoyant line or other means to secure it to a lifejacket worn by another person in the water as per LSA Code as amended by Regulation II/2.2.1.16



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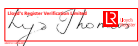
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8. A lifejacket shall be provided with a suitable means to allow a rescuer to lift the wearer from the water into a survival craft or rescue boat as per LSA Code as amended by Regulation II/2.2.1.17
9. The storage of this equipment is not part of this Design Appraisal or Certificate. All such arrangement are to be to the satisfaction of the attending Surveyors on board
10. If the specified standards are amended during the validity of this certificate, this product type is to be re-approved prior to it being supplied to vessels to which the amended standards apply
11. Production items are to be manufactured in accordance with either an approved Production Quality Assurance system (Module D) or Product Quality Assurance (Module E) or Product Verification (Module F) of the Marine Equipment Directive
12. Production tests are to be conducted in accordance with the applicable requirements of IMO Resolution MSC.81 (70), Part 2 and be recorded by the manufacturer in accordance with either the approved Production Quality Assurance system (Module D) or Product Quality Assurance (Module E) or witnessed by the Notified Body (LRV) as required by the Product Verification (Module F) of the Marine Equipment Directive. This does not preclude any further testing to additional requirements of the Marine Administration of the country where the ship is registered (i.e. the flag state) or those acting on behalf of that Administration
13. Each item, batch or lot of the equipment is to have the "Mark of Conformity" affixed and be issued with a "Declaration of Conformity"
14. Should a change of Place of Production from that stated below be required i.e. where the stages of manufacture/assembly/testing of this product take place, the new Place of Production is to be advised to us prior to the change taking place. This Certificate will require to be updated for Approval to be maintained
